Entrepreneurship Programme at Vivero

Our 21st Century Classroom at Vivero is outcome-based and focuses on what students 'know' and 'can do'; where the teacher is a 'facilitator' or a 'coach'. It is here where our unique Entrepreneurship curriculum interconnects students' interests, experiences, talents and their understanding of the 'real world' into their role in the community. This entrepreneurship-enriched curriculum seeks to fuse two learning settings: the traditional, formal school culture and the new informal, enterprising culture. While the former is hierarchical, orderly and predictable, the latter is free, intuitive and creative.

At Vivero our teachers plan and provide the

resources they need for creative expression and the key resource here is 'time'. Children are given ample amount of time for unstructured, child-directed, imaginative play -unencumbered by adult direction, and that which does not depend on a lot of commercial materials. Allowing children the freedom and autonomy to explore their ideas and do what they want is the key to giving them the opportunity to express "divergent thoughts." Focus is on encouraging them to find more than one route to a solution, and more than one solution to a problem! When they successfully solve a problem, they are not only motivated to solve it again but also to find new ways to go about solving it. Thus we see the emergence of a new age Entrepreneur!

The essence of the curriculum was beautifully illustrated by the children of Vivero as they collaborated, communicated and enthusiastically executed enterprising projects such as The Wrap & Scrap store, The Corn Stall, The Winter Wonderland & the Carnival Parade, daily duties of the Flamingoes and the Puppet Shows. 



The 'Big School' - Transitioning tips to K12

What will the children experience?

New Environment

The soothing familiarity of the preschool learning space is no longer available. The room is set up differently and there the washroom may no longer be in / next to the classroom anymore. Providing a visual description of the classroom or talking about it will help reduce anxiety around entering the new learning environment.

New Routines

This includes but is not limited to; an entrance routine in the morning, an exit routine for break and home-time, a lunch-time/ snack-time routine and a washroom routine (to name a few) - routines that are introduced in the first few weeks of school itself. For some this can be 'information overload' and may lead to some resistance & negative behaviors. Discussing these with the child well in advance may mentally prepare them for the upcoming change.

New Structure

While Preschools support a very play based learning environment; Grade 1 comes along with fixed seating arrangements & structured sessions for extended periods of time. It now involves a lot more paper and pencil work and a lot less moving around the classroom. Here again, for some learners this change might be a little overwhelming. As parents, prepare yourself first by incorporating some more structure into your child's day at home before the start of the new academic year.

As children move from pre-school to primary school, things are about to get more formal, more structured, and a lot more demanding.

Most children are easily able to navigate the changes but for some it can be quite daunting. It is here that 'successful transition' comes into play; helping children to adapt to new settings positively. The process of transitions sets the tone and direction in a child's school journey. This handling of this significant juncture may have a lasting influence on not only how children view themselves but also on how others value them along with their sense of well-being and the ability to learn.

The dynamics of shifting to a primary school can be made more amiable for the child if the immediate family & caregivers are also prepared for the forthcoming changes. Parents must continue to provide a socially engaging environment and involve the children in active experiences that promote growth and learning. Parents are advised to be patient with the child. Understand that this is a big transition, and it may take a few weeks or months for them to start enjoying Grade 1. The more you support your child's transition at home, the happier your first-grader will be moving ahead!



What should parents look for in the new school environment?

Children' rights: Schools should care for each child's well-being and should work to nurture their development by providing an environment where rights are promoted and protected while ensuring that young children understand this at all times.

Culture: The philosophy, vision and mission of the school should be positive and credible. The way teachers and other staff members work together and the set of beliefs, values, they share should promote the child's ability to learn and grow.

Continuity: The school should seamlessly provide continuity between early learning basics and the gradual advance of education into primary school. At the same time the continuity between the child's home environment and the primary school environment should also be taken into account to make the transition as gentle as possible.

Curriculum: Aligned standards ensure stability across the components of a child-centered educational system. Check for schools that use the child's developmental cycles to organize an integrated curriculum for primary school.

Conducive Environment: Refers to the extent to which effort and resources are invested in creating stimulating classrooms that support active learning.

Communication: Schools should be equipped & open to opportunities for parent and family involvement. Attention here is to be given to how & to what extent communication between home and the school is managed?
